Pray for Jenny and Sarah that they continue to be guided and supported, through prayer and in practical ways, to enable them to meet the needs of the women seeking their support.

Also pray that suitable volunteers will come forward to help give extra support with their work.



Jenny has especially asked prayer for:

- the healing of the women - body, soul and mind
- that new women would continue to come along
- protection for her and Sarah as they lead the groups and seek to reach women on a weekly basis
- for those who've made enquiries about WT via text that they would have the courage to come along
- wisdom to know how to help the women effectively
- The TK Centre, for its speedy completion so that there is a rehab centre nearby for those who need to access rehabilitation.
